

#### **ABOUT ACADEMY AKAUSHI**

Barbara Roberts-Thomson started breeding black Wagyu cattle in 1998 under the prefix ACC (Academy Cattle Co.) while a successful Hereford breeder. In 2008 she purchased four Akaushi cows and one sire KALFC0402. These were direct descendants of the original Red Wagyu that went to America from Japan.

There were two exceptional cows in the group, the first KALFB0234, the dam of Master Chef and granddam of Recital J34. The first two calves that Barbara bred were extremely good - Master Chef E146 and his half-brother Tambo E161 - the sire of **Tambo H18**. Master Chef's maternal sister Academy Reiko F10 was The Champion of the World 2015, she is the dam of **Recital J34**. The other outstanding cow was KALFB0647 the dam of **International P107**.

**Recital J34** is line bred to the great sire Big Al. He is a beautifully balanced bull in both phenotype and figures but his most outstanding feature is his +.5 for Marble Score. This makes him the = highest marbling bull alive in Australia on Breedplan. His other outstanding features are his milk, scrotal size, and carcass weight, and his exceedingly soft hair. He walks gracefully, has average birth weights and is a Trait Leader for 200-day weight in Australia.

**Tambo H18** is a grandson of the original Tamamaru who was one of the best for marbling. H18's dam Coats Big Al E424 grew into a most attractive, very big, heavy milking, cow. It is from both sire and dam that Tambo H18 gets his exceptional length, his very good milk, big testicles, heavy carcass weight and quiet temperament. Neither Tambo nor Recital were ever grain fed, were both used as yearlings and are photographed in paddock condition, as is International P107.

**International P107** is the son of the other great cow Kalanga B647. She was a very big cow, beautifully breed from an exceptional cow family. B647 had only 6 daughters in Australia and all of them outstanding, see back cover photo of P107's full sister P105's. Her last bull AWSFS80 is the highest bull on Breedplan for growth and sold this year for an Akaushi record of \$45,000. P107 is a very big bull, so not suitable for heifers. He is structurally very correct, with exceptional growth and carcass weight, and good milk. A big free moving bull, with excellent feet and legs and very quiet.
